

| Year 6 - Autumn 2 | Journeys |
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| English | We are going to explore writing units that are based on our reading text - Journey to the River Sea. We will be writing to persuade in the form of a letter and to entertain in a narrative with description. |
| Maths | Following White Rose, we are going continue to learn about fractions. Pupils will learn to multiply and divide fractions and find fractions of an amount. We will also explore measurement and conversions between units before moving onto the concept of ratio. |
| Reading | We will be reading Journey to the River Sea by Eva Ibbotson. |
| Science | We will study how we classify living things by looking at their observable characteristics. Our key scientist will be Carl Linnaeus. |
| DT | We will be designing festival lights using our knowledge of series circuits from our Science learning last term. We will expand our understanding of the design process by focussing on the effect of design constraints. |
| Geography | We will explore the geographical and cultural differences between the UK and Brazil. |
| Music | This term, pupils will be learning about the importance of the arrangement of music to create mood. They will use the music from Moana as their inspiration for their composition and performance. |
| Computing | In computing, we are using our new chromebooks to learn how to organise, manipulate and present data in Google Sheets. |
| Latin | We will complete our unit, 'How Beautiful'. In this, the children will learn how to join clauses using conjunctions in Latin. They will explore jewellery and how the Romans made themselves more beautiful. |
| RE | This term's focus is on Christianity and we the key question will be: Do Christmas celebrations and traditions help Christians understand who Jesus was and why he was born? |
| PE | We will be learning the skills and rules of tag rugby. |
