Music	This term, pupils will be learning about the importance of
	the arrangement of music to create mood. They will use the

Computing	In computing, we are using our new chromebooks to learn
	how to organise, manipulate and present data in Google

Latin	We will complete our unit, 'How Beautiful'. In this, the
