English

We will be learning to write character descriptions based on Roman mythology. We will also be writing persuasive letters linked to the text The Day the Crayons Quit.

Maths

We will be using White Rose Maths to facilitate our Maths learning. We will extend our understanding of multiplication and division as well as exploring new topics of measurement and fractions.

Music

Pentatonic Melodies, this involves exploring 5 scale notes using xylophones.

Romans

History

Our focus will be the Roman Empire and its impact on Britain, including Boudicca, the legacy of the Romans and Roman buildings.

Science
