

Spring 2	
Writing	In writing this half term, we will be exploring non-chronological reports and creating a report from our Science learning about materials. We will then revisit the genre of persuasive adverts, where we will use our History and reading learning to persuade children to come to a workhouse.
Maths	This half term in Maths, will be learning about perimeter and area, followed by statistics. Additionally, we will be continuing to revisit the four operations in our arithmetic lessons.
Reading	We are reading Street Child by Berlie Doherty, which is linked to our History unit of the Industrial Revolution.
DT	In DT, we will be learning about the purpose of bridges. Using a design brief, we will become builders and architects to design and create our own bridge for a purpose.
History	We will be learning about the Industrial Revolution, specifically looking at how Reading was effected by it. We will be exploring the three B's of Reading.
Computing	In Computing, we will be learning how to read and interpret data efficiently, organising our own data and using avatars to add to data.
Science	This term we will be building on our knowledge of properties of materials. We will be looking at the key question 'are all changes in materials irreversible' and carrying out many experiments to help answer this.
RE	Christianity is our religion for this half term. We will be exploring out key questions of: 'How significant is it for Christians to believe that God intended Jesus to die?'
Latin	We will continue our unit 'Clean and Healthy' this half term. In this unit, our grammatical focus will be adverbs and how to identify their endings in Latin. Additionally, we will be learning about medicine and how Romans stayed clean and healthy.
PE	In indoor PE, we will be learning new Yoga poses and how Yoga can help with flexibility and calming. In outdoor PE, we will explore the sport of Netball by learning to throw, catch and play according to the rules in a team sport.
Connect	In PSHE this half term, we will be exploring how we can connect to others. We will continue to complete tasks from the Knighthood programme throughout this half term.
Music	In music, we are beginning to learn our new instrument: the recorder. We will be listening to pieces of music that are played on the recorder and beginning to learn music notes. By the end of the unit, we will be reading music including three notes and playing these on the recorder.
