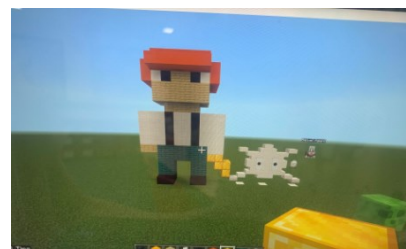

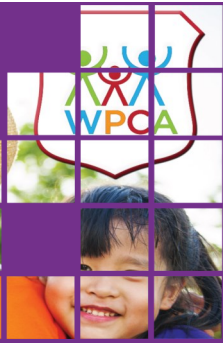

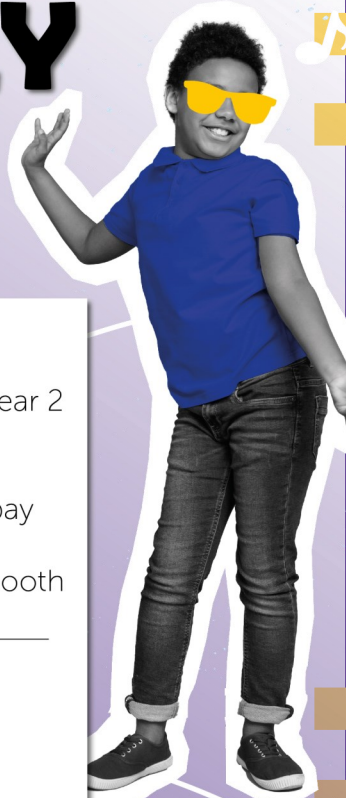
My most memorable moment in the role was being able to officially open the play equipment and seeing how excited the children were to receive it.
