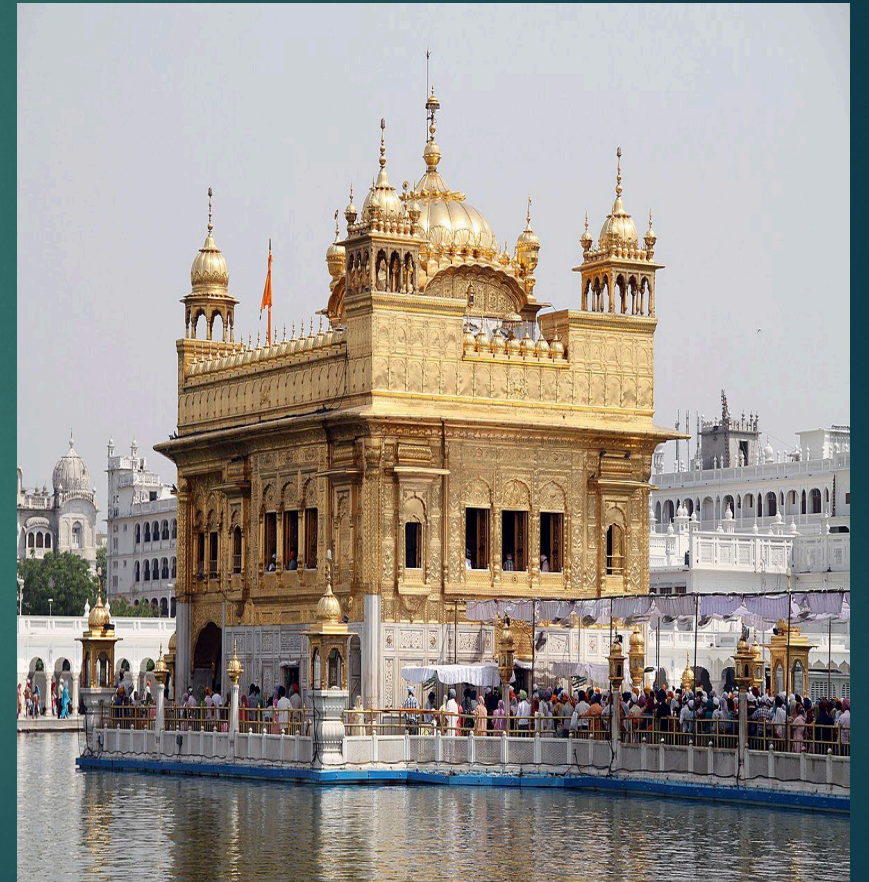

The Golden Temple is the most holy place for a Sikh. Every Sikh's dream is to go here at least once in their lifetime.

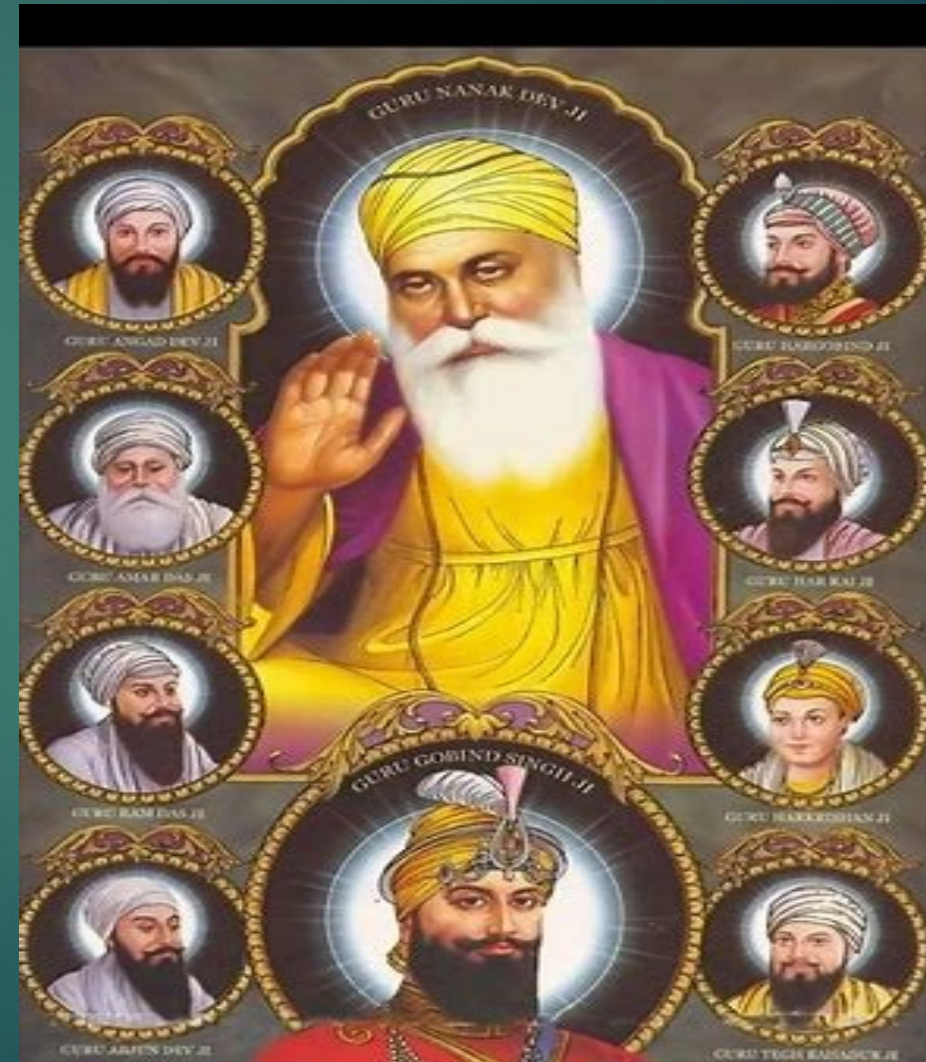
