To record an absence, click on the Quick Actions button (=) at the bottom left hand corner in your app, and then click Attendance. From there, click the green Log Absence button.

Please ensure you provide a reason for the absence, including any symptoms your child is experiencing. Once the absence is logged in Arbor, school will approve or reject the absence. Approved absences will appear in the Attendance tab of your Arbor App. School will follow up all absences that are rejected.
