WRAPAROUND CHILDCARE PROGRAMME:

The Department for Education launched the Wraparound Childcare Programme last year, aiming for all schools to offer childcare from 8am to 6pm, Monday to Friday, during term time. A Wokingham Parent Survey found that many families who don't use wraparound care cite the 'cost of sessions' as the main barrier.

Tax-Free Childcare or the childcare element of Universal Credit could help reduce costs—check if you're eligible. Find out more.
