For emergencies only situations, the school office may administer non-prescription medication provided that consent (this includes Arbor consents) has been obtained in advance.

GUARDIAN CONSULTATIONS: 11th and 12th December 2024 Bookings for December's Guardian Consultations closes at 1200 on 05.12.2024. Please book early and within that timeframe to avoid disappointment.

> Once the bookings have closed on Arbor, you will need to contact the class teacher directly. The school office will forward any email requests but cannot make any adjustments without the class teacher's involvement.

> This year we are holding the 10-minute consultations in the school hall. Space will be sufficient for teaching staff and guardians; however, we do request that pupils and siblings are not brought to the consultations. This is not just a matter of space, more that consultations between guardians and teachers lead to a more focused and elevated conversation about your child and their progress.

> As ever, if you have a concern or a query about your child, you do not need to wait until the consultation to raise it. You are always welcome to contact to the school office who will arrange a meeting with yourself and the class teacher separate to the consultation. Equally, if your 10-minute consultation raises the need for further conversation, you can contact the school office to arrange a follow up meeting.

Please note that for separated parents we are unable to accommodate separate consultations. We welcome both parents to the consultation or for the parents to liaise and communicate directly with each other. Please refer to our website for our Separated Parents Policy for further information.



Hello from the new WPCA Committee!

The Whiteknights Parents Community Association (WPCA) organises a range of fun activities for children throughout the year, while also raising funds to enhance the educational experience at Whiteknights. In recent years, our focus has been on improving the playground with new markings, play equipment, and a bike storage area.

We have lots of exciting events planned for the coming year! The **disco** will be held on Friday, 6th December—4:30-5:30pm for Years 1-3 and 6:00-7:30pm for Years 4-6. We're also organising a **Reception film night** on Thursday, 5th December. More details for both events will be shared soon. Additionally, parents of Nursery, Reception, and KS1 children can order **tea towels and coasters** via Scopay until 15th November, and we will have **Christmas decorations** for children to decorate on sale at the beginning of December. Looking ahead, we're planning our annual **summer fair, non-uniform days, sweet sales,** and the return of **Happy's Circus** in July. Due to a reduction in fares received for textile recycling, we will not be continuing with Bag2School, but we're exploring a new clothing recycling company—watch this space!

The recent non-uniform day before half-term raised £366. We're pleased to announce that, by combining this with existing WPCA funds, we've funded the purchase of 16 new tablets and cases—one for each class—to support the Knighthood Scheme launching in January.
