## Physical Development:

## Physical, Social, Emotional Development

## Literacy:

## Expressive arts and design:

## Communication and Language:

Answer the question: What would you like to play with? Using a full sentence.

## Maths:

Explore numbers 1, 2, 3 by: comparing numbers using more, fewer and the same as. Showing different compositions and recognising and naming circles, semi-circles and triangles.

**Key Question:** What special power does your superhero have?

## Key facts

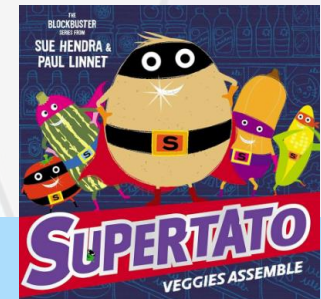
A vegetable is a plant that you eat.
