





Due to parents evenings in the school hall on Tuesday 24th March and Wednesday 25th March, the After School Club will be held in Crystal Classroom.


When arriving for pick up, please make your way to the school office and use the phone left on the shelf to call through to Crystal class to let them know you have arrived. They will then bring your child/children to you.










YEAR 3 BOUDICCA

YEAR 5 TRIP TO READING UNIVERSITY

On Monday, Year 5 visited the Harris Gardens in Reading University to explore life cycles of animals. They started by going on a scavenger hunt to find a range of plants and pollinators. Then, they organised seeds into groups depending on how they are dispersed. Finally, they were given a range of smelly tubes and we had to work out what plant scents they were. Some smelt lovely like the roses and raspberries but also some gross smells like the corpse plant!



