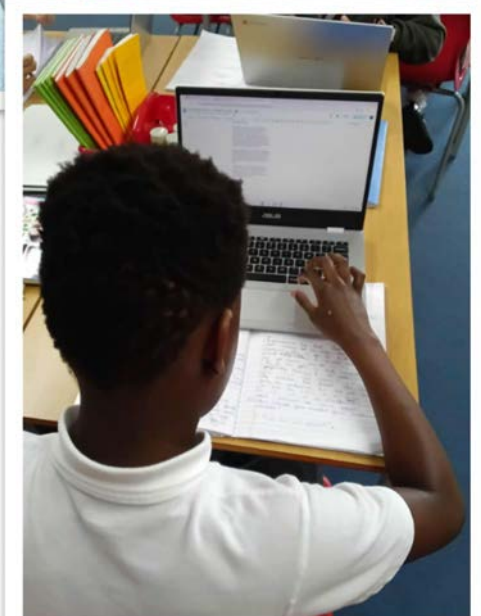
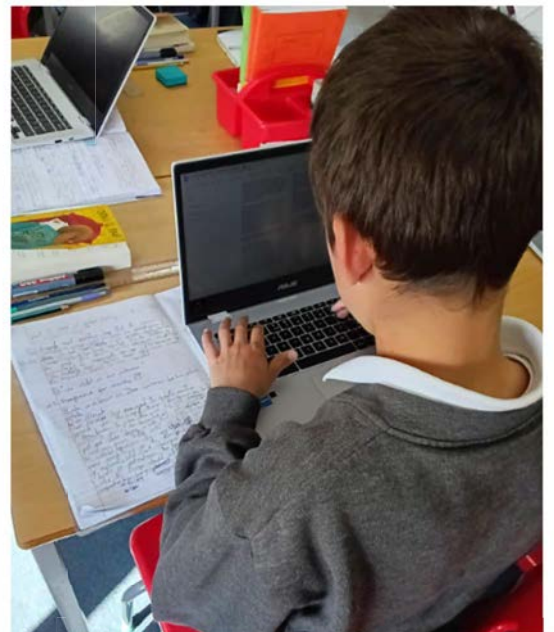
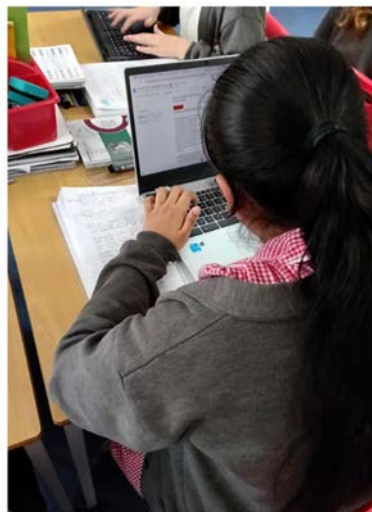
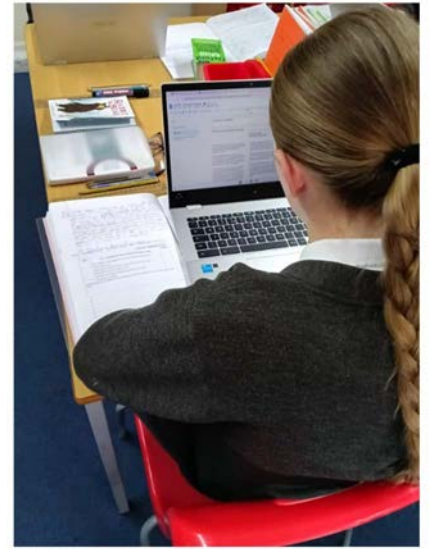
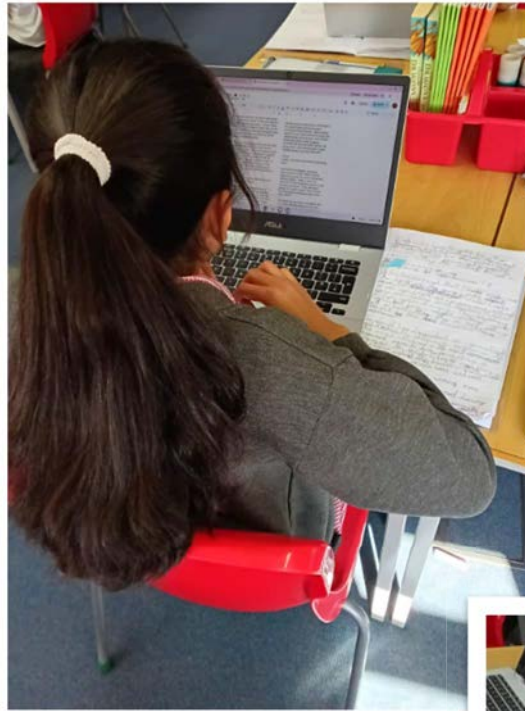


CELEBRATING WHITEKNIGHTS

Year 6 have become journalists and have been busy writing newspapers; they have been using the laptops to create their final pieces.

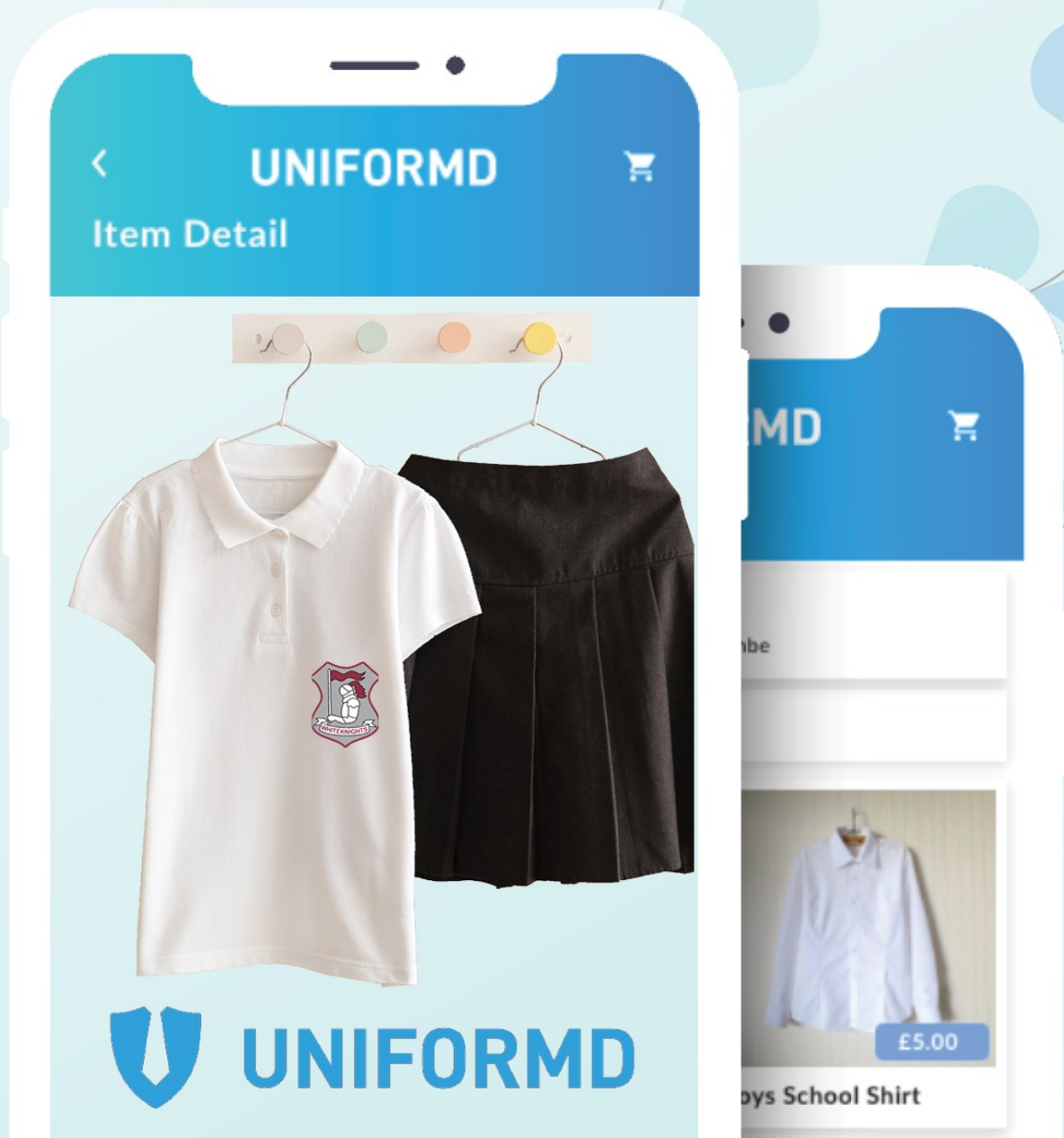
We also have a year 6 pupil, who knows a journalist that prepared some top tips to inspire the year 6 writers!
