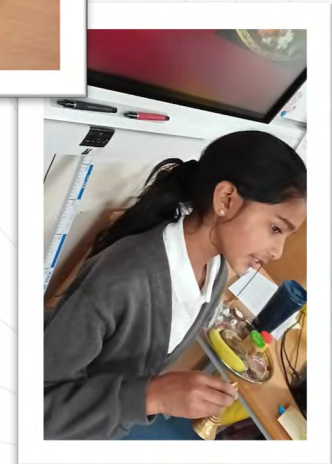
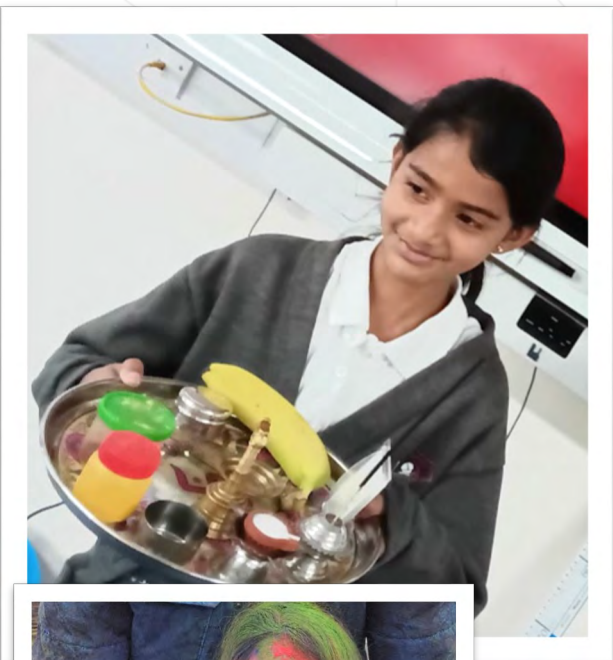
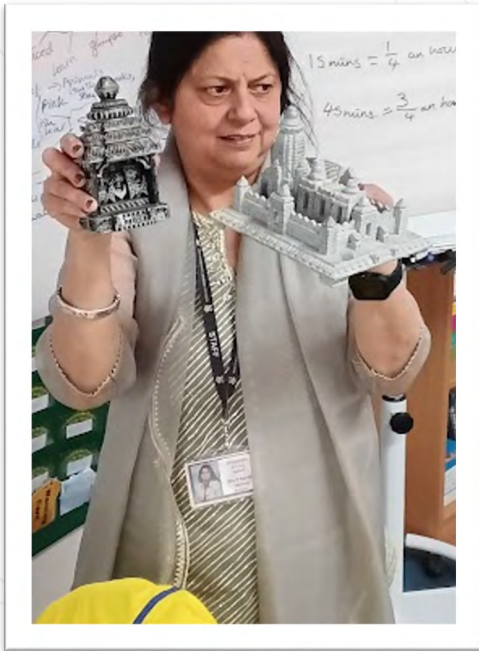




YEAR 3 EXPLORE THE MEANING BEHIND POOJAS
